### **Staging Details**

1. *Staging of entries can take place from 9.30 up until 10.30am on the morning of the show.*
2. *Judging will commence at 10:30am.*

### **Rules**

1. *Entries must have been grown by the exhibitor at Jubilee Allotments (excludes cookery and children's classes).*
2. *Entry Fees: 10p each exhibit.*
3. *Whenever possible, all exhibits must be labelled by the exhibitor.*
4. *The decision of the judges is final.*
5. *All trophies remain the property of the JAA. Holders are required to hold the trophy in safe custody for 12 months until they are returned to the JAA for the following year's show.*
6. *Exhibits to be removed by 2.30pm on the day of the show.*

3. *Three Onions*
4. *A Plate of any Fruit (includes Rhubarb)*
5. *Two courgettes*
6. *Three of any Variety of Vegetable different to above*
7. *Largest/Quirkiest Vegetable\**

### **Cookery Classes**

1. *A Jar of Jam (any size – ingredients shown).*
2. *A Jar of Chutney (any size – ingredients shown).*
3. *Any Item of Baking*

### **Children's Classes**

1. *A Vegetable Animal*
2. *An Edible Necklace*
